More and Better Affordable Homes



We Are Bringing More and Better Affordable Homes to the Borough

What We've Delivered:

- Increased the affordable housing target in the new Local Plan to 40% on major developments (up from 35%)
- Set a target that 70% of affordable homes should be social housing
- Built more high-quality, energy-efficient council homes at Gorse Ride in Finchampstead
- Delivered new specialist housing, including:
 - Seaford Court – new accommodation for care leavers
 - Supported living homes in Woodley for young disabled residents
- Protected over 100 new green spaces in the Local Plan
- Introduced strong energy efficiency standards so new homes are cheaper to run

What We Will Do:

- Deliver the full regeneration of Gorse Ride by 2028
- Partner with community groups to deliver high-quality social and affordable homes
- Ensure new developments include sustainable transport and safe layouts
- Protect our borough from speculative, unplanned development
- Deliver affordable homes that are warm, low-carbon and built to last





We Are Making Our Roads Safer

We Are Championing Safe and Sustainable Travel

What We've Delivered:

- An 8% increase in the roads maintenance budget for 2026/7
- A long-term plan to improve local transport – however you travel – for people, the economy and the environment
- Launched the “Safer Streets” programme to protect those most at risk on our roads
- Invested in bus services, including more buses on key routes such as the Leopard 3 between Wokingham, Barkham, Finchampstead and Arborfield Green
- Extended the timings for disabled bus passes to help people travel to work
- Innovation to get the most from our roads funding, reducing potholes and enhancing safety

What We Will Do:

- Invest an extra £5.5M in improving our roads, pavements, cycleways and drainage over the next 3 years
- Set safer speed limits in residential neighbourhoods, town and village centres and rural roads across the borough, responding to your priorities
- Make train stations more accessible, with better car parking, buses, and cycle security
- Deliver hundreds more EV charging points
- Make walking, cycling and buses realistic travel choices for local journeys, reducing congestion and improving the environment
- Create safer routes for school travel



More Local Provision for Children with SEND



We Are Providing More Local Provision for Children with Special Educational Needs

What We've Delivered:

- Opened two new specialist SEND units: One at Loddon Primary School and The Lilypad at Radstock Primary School for children aged 4-11 with autism and additional needs
- Confirmed three new SEND units at Walter Infant, St Paul's Junior and Winnersh Primary – adding 40 places
- Secured £13 million government funding for a new special free school at Rooks Nest Farm (opening planned for 2028)
- Delivered supported living homes for young disabled residents

And 98% of secondary school entrants got into one of their preferred schools in both 2025 and 2026 - the best ever in Wokingham Borough!

What We Will Do:

- Deliver the new special free school in 2028
- Open a post-16 SEND hub at the former library on Denmark Street - offering core subjects, vocational training and independent living skills
- Continue expanding local SEND provision to reduce out-of-borough placements
- Increase specialist support in mainstream schools
- Improve early intervention through Best Start family hubs
- Ensure SEND services are financially sustainable while improving outcomes
